### **Doppler-guided HAL (Hemorrhoidal Artery Ligation)**

- Minimally-invasive treatment for lower grades of haemorrhoids

### **HAL (Hemorrhoidal Artery Ligation + RAR (Recto Anal Repair))**

- Mucopexy of prolapsing mucosa
- No tissue resection necessary
- Low-pain and low-risk treatment for more severe hemorrhoids
