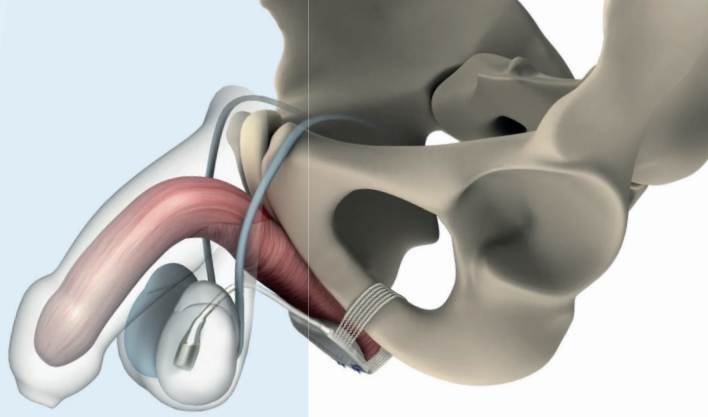

In the field of research, he has authored numerous publications in renowned journals and currently leads, among other projects, the PRACTICE study on structured prehabilitation prior to major urological surgeries.
