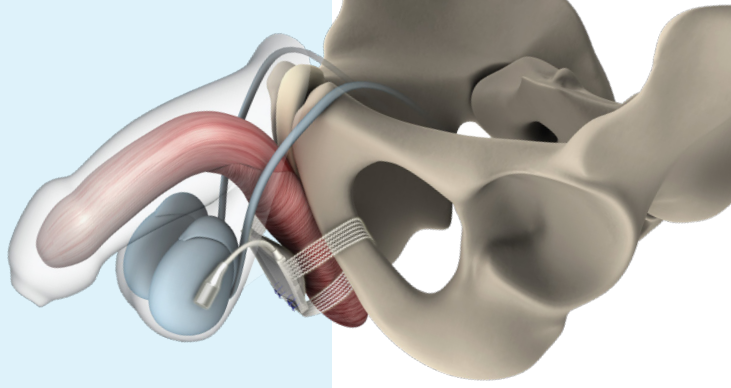

In 2012, Dr Fabian Queissert joined the team at Münster University Hospital. Since 2016, he has been head of the neurourology department and the continence centre. In addition to implanting slings and artificial sphincters, he also began working with ATOMS and thus significantly expanded the spectrum for treating male urinary incontinence.

Dr Queissert is a member of renowned research groups and took part in several ATOMS studies. Among others, he was part of the DOMINO study, which investigated therapeutic and surgical measures for male postoperative stress incontinence in over 1,200 men.

Especially after radical prostatectomy, the treatment of male stress incontinence remains a challenge.

In an intensive workshop you will receive information on the treatment of male urinary incontinence as well as tips on the correct indication and patient selection of different implants.

In the context of live surgery, the most important surgical steps for a perfect result will be clearly demonstrated to you. At the same time, you will have the opportunity to ask questions.
